Harold Slemmer has been executive director of the Arizona Interscholastic Association since 1999 and has stood at the forefront of the state's Pursuing Victory With Honor sportsmanship initiative since its implementation.

During his career, he's coached a variety of sports and was an assistant principal before becoming the inaugural principal of Mountain Pointe High School in Phoenix, Arizona. Since 1992, he's served as a part-time instructor for Northern Arizona University and Arizona State University, teaching graduate courses in educational leadership.

Dr. Slemmer has delivered workshops and made presentations on a variety of educational topics in over a dozen states. He's received certifications in professional training and accumulated honors as a student-athlete, coach, and administrator including the North Central Accreditation Circle of Excellence Award and the National Football Federation Distinguished Arizonan Award. During Governor Jane Dee Hull's term, he served on her Commission on Character Education.
