Larry Smith is a multi-jurisdictional mediator and arbitrator for the Superior Court system and in private practice. He holds a multi-disciplinary Ph.D. in Biblical Studies and Applied Ethics and a Master of Behavior Science degree with post-graduate work in cross-cultural conflict management.

An ex-Marine and Vietnam veteran, Dr. Smith was awarded the Bronze Star for Valor.
